Membership Requirements:

Undergraduate Students

- 12 semester hours (4 courses) in History (USF, AP, and transfer credit apply)
- A minimum GPA of 3.1 in History and 3.0 GPA overall are required.

Graduate Students

- completed one semester of coursework towards their Master's Degree in History
- have a GPA of better than 3.5
