

Election Requirements

All candidates **must** submit this application through Bullsconnect by 11:59 PM Friday, September 18th, 2026. Additionally, supporting documents are to be submitted through the 2026 Candidate Canvas Course by September 25th 9:00 AM. All candidates must attend at least one informational meeting via Teams by September 25th at 11:59 PM. The dates and times are listed below. The Teams links can be found on the Canvas Course. If your schedule conflicts with all the times listed below, contact the Supervisor of Elections to request an individual appointment **at least 24 hours** prior to the final listed meeting time. If you fail to complete any of these requirements, you will be **disqualified** from the election and will not be placed on the ballot.

SG Membership Requirements:

Candidates **MUST** be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours as an undergraduate or 4 credit hours as a graduate degree-seeking student and maintain **AT LEAST** an institutional GPA of 2.5 for undergraduate students and a 3.0 GPA for graduate students and may not be under disciplinary probation, suspension, or expulsion by the university. The attestation signed above allows for the verification of these details by SG Advising staff. This process will take place from September 21st-September 25th. You will be notified if you do not meet these requirements by a member of SG Advising Staff.
