- Community and youth engagement and environmental education
- Pre-construction surveys, including site assessment and species identification
- Monitoring water quality and ecosystem health
- Data collection and analysis using scientific methods
- Use of GPS, underwater cameras, and GIS mapping
- Seagrass planting and transplanting
(during planting season only)

- Boat ride for quadrant and transect line sampling to study seagrass health
